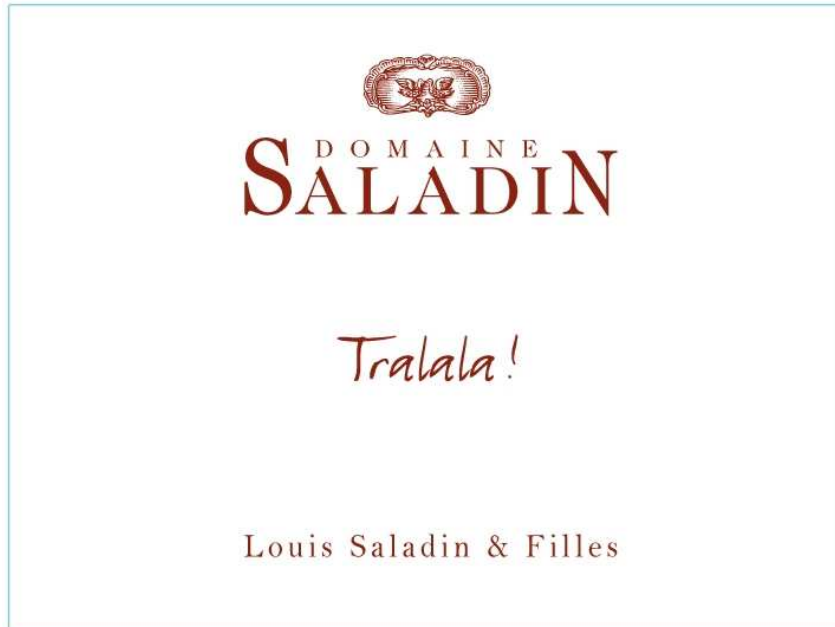




Louis, Annick Saladin & Filles
Vignerons-Paysans à St Marcel d'Ardèche
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Rosé « Tralala ! » Côtes du Rhône Rosé

Varietals:

Old Cinsault and Grenache Noir by 'saignée' (draining) and cold pre-maceration, depending on the vintage.

"Tralala!" is light-hearted, a 'jester's wine', the mirror image of Stephane, the son and chef !

'Terroir':

The vines are situated on argillaceous limestone soil with southern exposure and bordered by pine trees and brooms. With 40 year old vines, the yield is 30 hectolitres per hectare.

Vineyard tended to in a natural way and is chemical-free from day one. Wine is 'Agriculture Biologique' (Certified Organic) by 'Ecocert.'

Vinification:

Grapes are hand-picked. Only a very small dose of sulphite is used. Grapes then go through a slow fermentation at a low temperature in an underground vat (with no artificial yeast or other chemicals), aging in stainless steel.
