

## Loï Côtes du Rhône Red

"Loï," the red Côtes du Rhône, brings its creator, Louis Saladin, to the fore. "Loï" is the Provençal nickname for Louis. It also pays tribute to Saint Louis, "Looïs," an adversary of Sultan Saladin during the 13th century crusades.

## Varietals:

Predominantly Grenache (red and white) rounded off by some Syrah and Carignan.

## 'Terroir':

With Southern exposure, from a plot with argillaceous limestone soil, bordered by pine trees and brooms. The 40 year old vines yield 35 hectolitres per hectare. Winemakers, Elisabeth and Marie-Laurence Saladin, are the family's 21<sub>st</sub> generation to tend the land and vines. No chemicals of any kind have ever been used at the property. Wine is 'Agriculture Biologique (Certified Organic) by 'Ecocert.'

## Vinification:

Grapes are hand-picked and the Grenache and Carignan are blended in small vats. A short semi—carbonic maceration takes place with no chemical additives except for a very limited amount of sulphite, then the wine is aged for nine months in concrete tanks.
